Scholarship Purpose: Established in memory of Toni Berke Foster, who taught at Black Butte School, this fund is for academic or vocational scholarships to students who have attended a school in Camp Sherman, Oregon.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Graduating high school seniors and prior graduates who have attended Black Butte School
- Attending any 2- or 4-year public or private college or university, including community college and career technical schools, anywhere in the United States
- Enrolling full-time
- Demonstrated financial need (FAFSA/ORSAA required)



Preferred Criteria

- Students enrolling in career technical/vocational programs
